Team Response to Advanced Airway Crises

A simulation-based airway course for critical care medical and nursing staff

Critical care staff often find themselves having to work together in times of high stress to manage the **airways of acutely unwell patients**. Apart from not knowing each other, there may be differences in the management techniques that add a level of difficulty to an already challenging situation.

TRAAC is a comprehensive, interactive one-day program designed for **registrars** and **nursing staff** of the **critical care specialties** to assist them in developing the knowledge and skills required to effectively manage patients with compromised airways.

The course is open to **12 participants** (2 registrars and 2 nursing staff) from each of the **Anaesthetics, Emergency Medicine** and **Intensive Care** programs. Please note; for anaesthetic trainees, the course is suited to first year anaesthetic registrars.

Along with the practical skills and technical knowledge required for advanced airway management, the course will also emphasise the importance of **non-technical skills**, such as effective leadership and communication; which known to be expert markers of **team performance**.
